



GUIDELINES FOR SHIPPING VEHICLE & SELF PROPELLED EQUIPMENT

SHIPMENT OF VEHICLES:

U.S. Customs Law states: Title of Vehicle must be stamped by U.S. Customs for a 72 hour clearing period (excluding day of delivery or day of shipping and weekends) prior to the shipping date.

Please note:

No personal effects may be placed inside the vehicle.

No more than ¼ tank of fuel should be in vehicle.

EXPORTATION OF VEHICLE REQUIRES THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

1. Title
2. Bill of Sale/Invoice
3. Letter of Intent
4. Notarized Power of Attorney Form
- 5) Copy of Driver's License or Passport

A BOOKING MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO DELIVERY TO THE PORT OF MIAMI
